God's Man has come!

- "You will conceive in your womb and bear a son and you shall call his name Jesus."
- Suffering Servant/Messiah who would be God's deliverer
 - God's salvation for His people

God-Man has come! (Our lives depend upon this truth)

- Jesus has come
- Vs. 35-the Holy Spirit will come upon you and overshadow you
- Overshadow appears in Exodus 40:35 speaking of God's presence
 - Shekinah glory "overshadowing the tabernacle in a cloud...also used in Luke 9:34 in reference to the transfiguration
- Vs. 35-the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God

God's Promised King has come!

(He is forever faithful to His promise)

- Vs. 32-Son of the Most High
- Vs. 32-"And the Lord God will give to Him the throne of his father David"

God has come!

- The kingdom never ends

- Because of the overshadowing of presence of the Most High God and because the Holy Spirit will come upon you, you may be assured that this Son will be called holy for He is the Son of God
- Here this also emphasizes Jesus deity
- God with us
- God for us
